AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SHOOTING OF ANY FIREARM, AIR RIFLE, OR OTHER WEAPON CAPABLE OF CAUSING BODILY HARM IN THE TOWN OF CHARLOTTE COURT HOUSE SO AS TO ENDANGER LIFE, LIMB, OR PROPERTY OF OTHERS AND PRESCRIBING THE PENALTIES THEREFOR:

If any person shoot any firearm, air rifle, or other weapon capable of causing bodily harm in any street or ally or public place in the Town of Charlotte Court House or shoot within the Town limits so as to endanger life, limb, or property of another, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$1000.00 or shall be confined to jail not to exceed one year.

An emergency existing, this ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage.
